

To Members Regarding Concrete Batching Plant

Your directors have been alerted to an application to Sechelt Council for a "temporary" (three year--renewable) rezoning to allow Stockwell Sand and Gravel to build and operate a concrete batching plant in our residential area, contrary to the Official Community Plan. Council has asked for a response by January 6th. We have done some research on plants of this kind, and find that there are issues with alkaline waste water, dust and noise. Accordingly, on your behalf, we have prepared a submission -- attached -- opposing this application. Our view is that there is no need for such an industrial operation to be built in our residential area when there is ample industrial land available in Sechelt. If you are in agreement, and share our concern, please take a moment to make your feelings known to Council.
